On my numerous visits to the island of Tresco, I have never ceased to find a peace and a sense of belonging. I hope that these paintings evoke the feelings that I get when painting them.












Will's inspiration normally comes from quite precise objects or images, however this time he particularly wanted to create something that focussed out from the details and referenced a wider area in an abstract fashion, without any part of the scenery standing out more than any other. Working similarly to a painter with a palette of colours, the aim was to create pieces that were evocative of particularly Tresco as a whole, but also the wider Scilly Isles.










